SAN SABA - Receipts totaled 3110. Buyers were on hand from several states including Florida, Alabama, Maryland, Louisiana, Arkansas, Missouri, Oklahoma, Kansas, Nebraska, South Dakota, Wyoming, Montana, Nevada and Texas. A good many of the English (Angus and Baldies) pairs and bred cows went to the Northern states with several of the Brangus and F1's going into Oklahoma, Missouri and the southeastern states where there has been abundant rainfall over the last month or so over. Over 1500 head of the 3110 moved out of state. The better, younger and fleshier pairs brought from \$1250 up to \$1640 with one set of 10 five year old Brangus pairs going for \$1825. The more solid mouth pairs and younger ones that were carrying less flesh sold from \$1075 up to \$1325. The bred cows that were fall and winter calving were in good demand selling from \$1025 up to \$1450 with one set of 16 Angus cross off the Moylan Cattle Company bringing \$1925 to calve in July and August. Most of the bred heifers that were offered were fall and winter calving that brought from \$1050 up to \$1575 with 3 sets off the Moylan Cattle Company going from \$1650 up to \$1900 on some show calf type heifers. The open heifers sold mostly in a range of \$850 to \$1040 depending on size and kind. A good many of the open Tiger stripe heifers went up to southwest Missouri. The sale was broadcast live over the internet with live bidding online and over the phone with over 10 loads being purchased this way.
