Jordan Cattle Auction Thursday, October 1, 2015

MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 1606 head for the week. The market continued the downward trend with the board limit down on a couple of days in the last seven and the fat cattle selling from \$120.00-\$124.00 with some extremely heavy weight (1600-2200 lbs) bringing less. The excess weight has created a supply of meat that needs to be moved through the market and until this happens it will continue to put extreme pressure on the market. The dry weather and lack of wheat grazing in a large area has put pressure on the lighter cattle in which the stocker steers sold \$10-\$25 lower and the heifers were \$10 lower. The bigger feeder steers were \$10-\$20 lower and the feeder heifers were \$10 lower. Pairs and bred cows were \$100-\$250 lower. Packer cows were steady and packer bulls were \$2 lower. The bull offering saw the Griswold Angus bulls averaging \$4870.00 with the top bull at \$5250.00, Jackson Branch bulls averaged \$4550.00 with the top bull at \$5400.00, Rafter J Hereford bulls averaged \$4125.00 and Lastovica yearling Angus bulls averaged near \$4000.00 with the top bull at \$7750.00.
