MASON & SAN SABA – Receipts totaled 2516 for the week. Demand was strong on all the lighter cattle going to graze out wheat or grass. The stocker steers sold \$3 higher with 7 steers 496 lbs \$171.00 (\$848.16) and the stocker heifers were a full \$7-\$10 higher. The feeder steers and heifers were fully steady with 7 steers 655 lbs \$146.00 (\$970.90). Packer cows and bulls were steady with the high bull at \$98.50 and the top cow at \$80.00. Most of the better younger pairs sold from \$1600.00 up to \$2350.00 depending on kind, flesh and size of the calf. A good offering of bred cows were on hand with the long bred spring calving cows ranging from \$1500.00 up to \$1625.00 except for a few that sold from \$1700.00-\$1800.00. The medium bred cows that were 4-6 months bred ranged from \$1325.00 to \$1500.00 depending on kind size and flesh. A few bred heifers were offered but not enough to really test the market. The open heifers went from \$925.00 up to \$1275.00 depending on kind and size.
