The overall market had a softer tone throughout the week with very little wheat grazing throughout the country and many feed yards lacking space to place additional cattle. The stocker steers and heifers sold \$5 to \$7 lower with 11 steers at 456 lbs \$167.00 (\$761.52) and 20 steers at 575 lbs \$143.00 (\$822.25). The feeder steers were \$5 lower with 33 at 771 lbs \$125.50 (\$967.61) and 4 at 831 lbs \$122.00 (\$1,013.82). Feeder heifers were \$3 lower. The fleshy fat calves weighing 550-800 lbs were \$5-\$10 lower. Packer cows sold \$3 lower and bulls were \$2 lower. Pairs and bred cows were steady on limited test with 7 F-1 Tigerstripe heifers at 660 lbs. \$70.00 (\$1,122.00). The Angus of Clear Creek's 15 coming 2 year old bulls avg. \$2,913.33 with the top bull at \$3,900 and the 15 yearling bull avg. \$1,736.60. The 30 total bulls avg. \$2,325.00.
