The stocker steers and heifers going to graze out wheat or grass all sold steady with 31 steers at 521 lbs \$175.50 (\$914.36). The feeder steers and heifers were steady with 2 steers at 658 lbs \$157.00 (\$1,033.66). Packer cows were \$5 higher and bulls were \$2 higher. Pairs and bred cows were in good demand due to green grass starting to show up in some areas.
