Bred Cows, Pairs, Bred and Open Heifers will be offered

- **40** Choice first calf Angus pair with Angus sired calves at their side weighing 250-300 lbs and have been left open for the bull of your choice. These pair are in excellent shape. They will catch your eye. (1)
- 125 Black & black white face pair with their first and second calves at their side out of Evans Ranch Angus bulls and registered Charolais bulls. Pairs will be selling back as open for the bull of your choice. This is a nice set of young pair that will be sorted for uniformity. (2)
- **95** Second calf black and black white face cows bred to calve this spring to Evans Angus and registered Charolais bulls. Cows are gentle and in good condition. (3)
- **40** First calf Brangus pair with Angus calves at their side weighing 250-300 lbs. Pairs will be selling back as open for the bull of your choice. They are in excellent flesh and will make someone a choice set of pairs for the future.(4)
- 8 Fancy Brangus pair with their first calf at their side out of Angus bulls. Cows are open to breed to the bull of your choice. (5)
- **30** One raising set of first calf Charbray pair with Angus sired calves at their side. This is an exceptional set of calf raisers that are open and ready for the bull of your choice. (6)
- **30** Choice open Brangus heifers that are all one raising and will be tagged as Black Gold Brangus Built. Heifers will not be carrying any brands or earmarks. They are all ocv and will be ready for the bulls this spring. All come to feed. These heifers will be coming from McKinnerney Brangus and AD McKinnerney.(7)
- 8 Open choice Brangus baldie heifers weighing 800 lbs. These heifers are all ocv and current on vaccinations. (8)
- **45** Angus or Angus plus cows that will be long bred to Hereford bulls. Cows are straight 4 years old and will weigh 1250-1300 lbs. They are all gentle and will come to feed. If you are looking for a good set of young cows don't miss these. Will sort the Angus from the Angus plus. (9)
- **94** Angus & Angus plus cows that are 3-4 years old long bred to Akaushi bulls. Cows were all ranch raised and will be sorted according to kind. This set is in the prime of their life. (10)
- **106** First calf Angus and Angus plus heifers that will be long bred to Akaushi bulls. Heifers are all raised on one ranch and will be sorted into uniform lots. (11)
- **200** Black and black baldies four year old cows that are all one raising and long bred to Akaushi bulls. These cows are in the prime of their life and have a lot of future. Could be a few calves by sale day. Baldies and blacks will sell separately. (12)
- 35 Four year old red cows long bred to Akaushi bulls. They are all one raising. (13)
- 10 Charolais cross cows that are four years old, one raising and bred to Akaushi bulls. (14)
- **12** Brangus heifers that will be long bred to a low birth weight Angus bull. Heifers are gentle, come to feed and are long aged and a good set. All are ocv. (15)
- **19** Open Tigerstripe heifers weighing 650 lbs. Heifers are ocv and will come to feed. (16)
- 20 Young Brangus cows that will be long bred to Angus bulls. Cows are in good flesh and will come to feed. Most cows will be 5 years old or younger. (17)
- 10 Brangus pair with Angus calves at their side. Pairs will be 5 years old or younger. (18)
- **30** Angus plus and Brangus cows that are 4-5 years old and long bred to Pharo Ranch Red Angus bulls. Cows were wormed in February with Cydectin pour on. This set of females are gentle and the right kind. Will sort according to kind. (19)
- **50** Angus and Angus plus pair that are 3-5 years old with calves out of W4 Ranch Hereford bulls and black bulls and exposed back to same bulls for a short period. Cows are in good flesh, wormed and given shots in September. They will have matching eartags. (20)
- **50** Angus and Angus plus cows that are 3-5 years old and long bred to W4 Ranch Hereford bulls and black bulls. Cows are gentle, come to feed and recently wormed and vaccinated. (21)

- 8 Choice open Brangus heifers weighing 850 lbs. These females are big, stout and gentle. They are ready for the bull of your choice. These would work for a pen of commercial heifers. (22)
- **25** Choice first calf Brangus pair that will have Angus calves at their side that are 1-3 months old. Heifers have been left open for the bull of your choice. They will come to feed and be the calf raising kind. They will weigh 1000 lbs and are in great shape. Don't miss this set! (23)
- 7 Angus pair that will have Wagyu calves at their side. Cows are solid mouth and have been left open for the bull of your choice. They are gentle and will come to feed. (24)
- **38** Home raised Angus plus heifers that will all be open and will weigh 800 lbs. Heifers are ocv and ready for the bull of your choice. Heifers will come to feed and will be gentle. (25)
- **42** Angus and black baldie cows that will be long bred to Langford Ranch Hereford bulls. Cows will be baby tooth on up to solid mouth. Baldies will sell separately from the Angus and will be sorted according to age. (26)
- **16** Fall calving mostly Angus cows with a few baldies and will be bred to Hereford bulls. Cows will be baby tooth up to solid mouth and will be sorted into groups according to age and color. (27)
- **17** Angus pair that have 250-300 lbs Angus calves at their side that are out of a Gardiner Objective Son. Pairs have not had a bull back with them so that you can breed them back to the bull of your choice. The pairs were raised on the ranch and will be a good jam up set of solid mouth set of pairs. They are gentle and will come to feed. (28)
- **10** Choice Angus heifers which 7 will have calves at their side out of a low birth weight Angus bull and three will be long bred to same bull. Heifers are weighing 1100 lbs and will be gentle. The pairs will be sold separately from the bred heifers. A good set of calf raisers. (29)
- 8 Angus heifers that will be selling as exposed to a low birth weight Brangus bull for 35 days. Heifers will weigh 700-750 lbs and be ocv. (30)
- 2 Registered first calf Angus pair that have a choice set of Angus calves at their side. Heifers will be selling back as open for the bull of your choice. They are gentle and easy to handle. (31)
- **7** Angus and black white face heifers that will be selling as long bred to low birth weight Express Ranch Angus bulls. Heifers are gentle and will come to feed. (32)
- 2 Choice Red Angus heifers that will be selling as long bred to low birth weight Donop Angus bull. (33)
- 3 One raising set of open True F-1 Tigerstripe heifers that will average 650-700 lbs. Heifers will be ideal for the bull of your choice this spring. Heifers are all ocv and current on all shots. (34)
- 2 Open Braford heifers that are a one raising set and will average 650-700 lbs. Heifers are gentle and current on shots and ocv. (35)
- **16** Angus plus and Brangus cows that are middle aged and long bred to Pharo Red Angus bulls. Cows are big, stout and come to feed. They were wormed in February with Cydectin pour on. (36)
- 20 Black & black white face heifers bred to low birth weight Evans Ranch Angus bulls to calve this spring.(37)
- 3 Fancy True Black F-1 heifers long bred to a <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Wagyu <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Angus bull. These females are gentle and come to cake. They are big and stout. (38)
- 4 Black white face cows that are three years old and bred to Angus and Charolais bulls. Cows will be medium bred and in good flesh. (39)
- **1** Fancy Brangus pair with an Angus sired calf at their side. This female is open to breed to the bull of your choice.(40)
- 2 Open Red Angus heifers out of registered stock. These females are 13 months old and will weigh 750 lbs. Heifers are all ocv and current on vaccinations. (41)
- 2 Gray Brahman cow that are 5 years old out of Hudgins bloodlines. One female is long bred to a registered Angus bull and the other will be selling as open. (42)
- 1 Registered Beefmaster cow that is 8 years old and medium bred to a registered Beefmaster bull. (43)
- 6 Chi Angus pair that are 4-5 years old with Chi Angus calves at their side that will average 300 lbs. Cows are exposed back to the same bull and should be 3in1's on sale day. Cows are all home raised and gentle.(44)
- **11** One raising set of Chi Angus cows that are 7-9 years old. Cows will be selling as medium to long bred to a Chi Angus bull. They are gentle and all home raised. (45)
- **75** Open Tigerstripe heifers that will average 675 lbs. Heifers will be current on all shots and ocv. They will be ideal for the bulls of your choice this spring. Heifers will be sorted into uniform groups for your liking.(46)
- 6 First calf Angus pair with a young Angus calves at their side. These mommas will weigh around 1100 lbs. All one raising. (47)
- **60** First calf long bred Angus heifers bred to low birth weight Angus bulls. Heifers are all one raising and will be long aged weighing 1100-1250 lbs. This kind of big long aged heifers are hard to find. (48)
- **5** First calf Angus pairs with big Angus calves at their side and have been running back with Angus bulls and should all be 3in1's. Big and good. (49)
- 21 First calf Red Angus pair with Angus sired calves at their side. Pairs are gentle and come to feed (50)

- **60** First calf Angus, Angus plus and baldies (have a touch of ear) that will have calves at their side out of Black or Red Angus bulls. Pairs are gentle and come to feed. They will be sorted into uniform groups according to kind. (51)
- 4 Horned Hereford cows medium to long bred to a ½ Black Angus ½ Red Angus bull. Cows are 4 years old. (52)
- **10** Second calf Hereford cows AI bred to sexed heifer semen out of JDH King of Clubs. These cows are long bred and are northern in origin. (53)
- **30** Three year old Hereford cows medium bred to Hudgins Gray Brahman bulls. These northern bred females will make a nice set of F-1 makers. (54)
- **16** Red Angus cows that are 4 years old to solid mouth medium to long bred to a Skeans Ranch registered Charolais bull. Cows are gentle and cake broke. (55)
- 6 Red Angus cows with Red Maine sired calves at their side and bred back to a Mike Mimms Smokin Bob son. Cows are 4-5 years old. (56)
- **3** True F-1 Tigerstripe heifers out of polled Hereford cows and a registered Hudgins Brahman bull. One heifer will weigh 750 lbs and two will weigh 550 lbs. Heifers are home raised and will be ocv. (57)
- **1** Registered Angus pair that will have a red calf at her side. She is 6 years old and has been running back with a SimAngus bull and should be a 3in1. (58)
- **1** Brangus pair that will have a calf at her side out of an Angus bull. She is solid mouth and has been running back with a SimAngus bull and should be a 3in1. (59)
- 2 Brangus cows long bred to a SimAngus bull. Cows are solid mouth. (60)
- 25 Black & black white face pair that are 3-5 years old with black calves at their side. Cows are open for the bull of your choice. (61)
- 20 Black & black white face cows long bred to black bulls. Cows are 3-5 years old. (62)
- **10** Brangus heifers weighing 950 lbs. These open females are all ocv and current on vaccinations. (63)
- **5** One raising set of open heifers weighing 725 lbs. Heifers are gentle, ocv, current on vaccinations and ready for the bull. (64)
